Oral History Publication Consent Protocol

You will notice that we obtain consent for the school/organization to use the story, and we separately ask for consent for the usage of the story in the creation and promotion of the publication. These are very deliberately two separate consents.

Sometime after the story is given, the constituent will receive an email with a link to the MyUpdate site. This site restates their consent options and gives them the right to change these options up until the deadline, which is also in the MyUpdate site.
